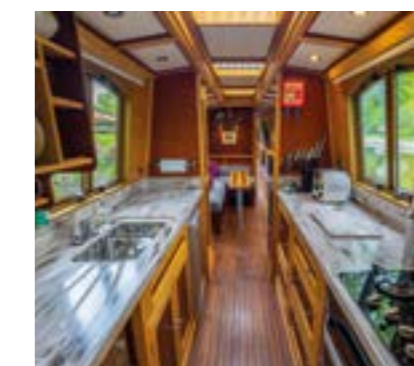
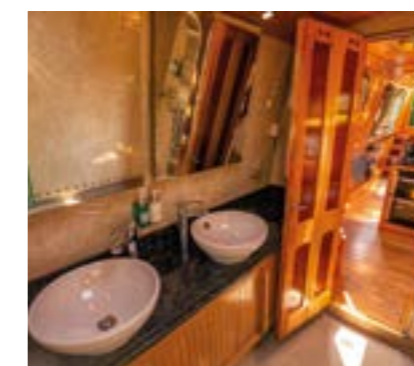
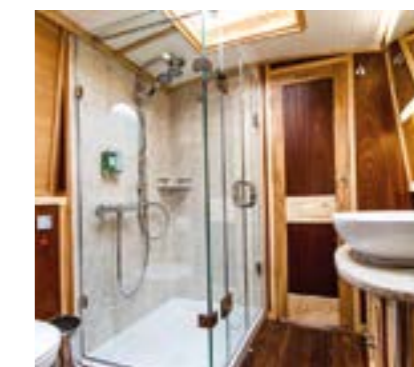
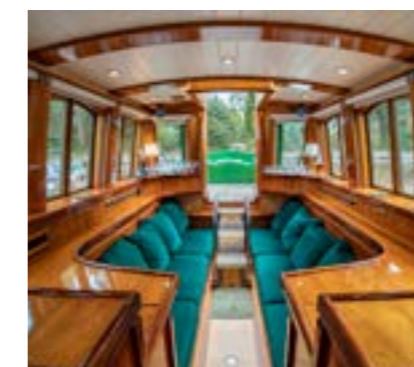
CRAFTSMANSHIP

We are confident that our luxury canal boats are second to none. It's a source of great pride that we design and hand-build each one at our base in Llangattock. The process begins from conversations with our customers and discovering what they would like to see onboard in order to make truly special holidays. We then draw up a plan, discuss it, refine it and build the boat to exacting standards, always with relaxation and convenience in mind. This can all take up to 12 months to achieve, but the result is a luxurious, comfortable and unique boat, tailor-made for the perfect holiday.

FINEST QUALITY

Some of our boats have bedrooms with en-suite shower rooms while Harrier has a double-ended bath and Owl has a hot tub on deck. The shower rooms have porcelain sanitaryware, showers with doors (no curtains here), toilets with push-button flushes, a good supply of hot water, fluffy white towels and luxury toiletries.

Furthermore, within the smartly-painted strong steel hull, you'll find the very highest specification finishes—oak, beech, mahogany, walnut and ash panelling and flooring, granite worktops, brass light fittings, wool carpets and designer fabrics.

OUR SUSTAINABLE BUSINESS SOLUTIONS

The beauty of the Brecon Beacons National Park inspires us to care deeply about our environment and to take action.

We hand craft all our luxury boats here on site, so we repurpose any leftover wood from the exterior to ensure a quality finish on the interior of our boats. We also invested in a log making briquette machine to turn any of our waste wood into fuel for your log burners for when you cosy up on your holiday.



We have installed 30KW of solar panels to reduce the amount of CO2 burnt at the power stations. Our solar panels allow you to charge your EV car whilst on holiday, giving you peace of mind and maintaining our environmentally friendly ethics.

To ensure we keep our high standard of quality on our boats, every winter we repaint the boats in our onsite heated workshop, so they're brand new for you to hire the following season. Our boathouse at Llangattock is heated by a highly efficient biomass wood burning boiler with a large water heat recovery system.



ECODESIGN WITH OUR BOATS

COOT AND ROBIN

We are immensely proud of Coot, our standout eco-friendly narrowboat. We were the first narrowboat company to offer its customers a hybrid narrowboat with additional solar input. She comes with solar panels, a low-energy induction hob, efficient LED lighting and a hybrid diesel/electric engine allowing you to cruise in near silence; her conventional engine only kicks in if you run out of battery power.

In 2023, Beacon Park Boats launched the canal's all electric canal boat Robin, where its batteries are charged from the building's solar panels. Robin is built with a bespoke heat pump design using the energy from the canal to produce the boats hot water and heating requirements. Solar panels have been installed on the top deck to aid your luxury necessities aboard your boat.

The rest of our boats use tried and tested, highly efficient, low-revving, low-emission diesel engines. They push the boat through the water at a comfortable 2.5mph, minimising the need for fuel as well as reducing carbon emissions.

We aim for eco-friendly solutions whenever we decide to refurbish a boat. Falcon is a case in point—her woodwork is Lignia (a sustainable alternative to Walnut), she has LED lighting throughout and her hull is painted in epoxy paint so she doesn't have to be repainted so often. Drake was also designed to have no gas aboard. When we upgrade our narrowboats we're installing energy saving LED lighting and including log burning stoves over gas.

Our dayboats make a great activity along the canal, with all 8 boats running with purely electrical engines and batteries charged from our solar system. For more eco-friendly fun we offer canoes, paddleboard and a cycle boat as additional activities.

HOW TO CHOOSE YOUR BOAT

STEP 1:

Decide how many there are in your party.

STEP 2:

Choose your dates and the length of time you want a holiday for. Please note we have a selection of Saturday boats for 7, 14 and 21 night holidays. We also have Monday and Friday start boats for mid week, weekend breaks or longer.

STEP 3:

Decide width and length of boat, noting that all boats, including our widest, longest boats are capable of navigating the whole canal and that all boats are perfect for 2 people. We are the only boat yard that offers 3 widths of boats, from our standard 6ft narrowboat to our own design 8ft 6 and one in the middle 7ft 6 wide.

STEP 4:

Choose your features, for example a log fire, covered front deck and so on.

STEP 5:

Choose your bed configuration, if you want single beds, saloon sleeping and so on.

STEP 6:

Go to the website, check its availability and book, or hold.

STEP 7:

Choose your add ons at checkout. You can choose any of the following: paddleboard hire, skipper hire, Mon & Brec canal book, bouquet of flowers or starlink broadband.

Although short in length, she's huge on craftsmanship and engineering and will compliment the rest of our fleet with her quality. Fitted with an induction hob and with hot water and heating generated by a solar-driven water source heat pump, she is truly revolutionary. She has wheel steering so you don't have to stand up all day, seated dining (inside and out). Robin is our smallest boat with a small living space but she really does have a lot of character and finesse. Robin has a canopy that once moored, you can use to cover the back deck. Note: Robin is unfortunately not pet friendly
